IW2 will take around nine months to complete, and is mainly achieved on-job.

WHICH SKILLS DOES IT COVER?

IW2 will give you the best practice ways of working which have been developed by industry, for industry. It covers main skills needed including:

- **Key information about the infrastructure works industry**
- **Health, safety and working within the busy infrastructure environment**
- **Good communication skills for onsite and dealing with public**
- **How to keep your work records and incident/accident reporting**
- **How to care and maintain your hand tools**
- **How to maintain basic machinery**
- **Hand spreading – how to best use hand tools to put down materials and compact them**
