Review of progress to date

The graduate profiles have now been approved. The minor modifications to the strategic purpose statement, agreed in our previous meeting [see previous minutes] will be included in the qualification admission process with an explanation.

Qualification development

The focus of this session was looking at the rest of the unit standards in the current qualification to see which ones were relevant to the approved graduate profile outcomes. It was decided that unit standard 20092 'Demonstrate knowledge of electricity transmission, distribution, plan & equipment was not required in this qualification'. With the focus on safety it was considered important that graduates were knowledgeable of the relevant electricity industry safety statutes and codes hence 12300 should remain and be updated. The first aid unit standards - which are core health standards must remain.

The following unit standards were discussed and modifications required noted;

10507 Use personal protection equipment within an electricity network environment,
12300 Demonstrate knowledge of electricity industry safety statutes and codes,
17026 Demonstrate knowledge of safe entry into restricted areas in an electricity supply environment,
18038 Demonstrate knowledge of and apply health and safety in the electrical supply environment
18275 Demonstrate knowledge of the New Zealand electricity supply industry

These comments have since been added as tracked changes to the existing unit standards and sent out to all members for feedback.
